#### PRACTICE NURSES

The Practice Nurses can advise you on managing minor illness, diabetes, high blood pressure and asthma and on ear syringing; they will also advise on travel immunisations, weight reduction and stopping smoking and well person checks (including cervical smears). **REGISTRATION**

If you live in our practice area, which extends to within a radius of approximately 6 miles from The Surgery, and would like to register with us, please complete a registration form which is available from reception. If you move out of the area, we regret that you must register with another practice. You will be registered with the practice rather than an individual GP and may see any of our doctors. You may ask to see a particular doctor and we will do our best to comply, wherever possible. It is helpful if you see the same doctor for an ongoing problem.

**APPOINTMENTS**

Patients are seen by appointment only; to make an appointment, please speak to the receptionist or telephone the surgery between **8.30 am – 6.00 pm**. Please be as prompt as possible for your appointment and please notify us of any cancellations. We will always see urgent cases on the same day; if you feel you need to be seen urgently, please inform the receptionist. The surgery is closed between 1.30 pm – 2.00 pm; if you need the doctor urgently during this time, please telephone the surgery.

**SPEAKING TO THE DOCTOR**

Many queries can be dealt with over the telephone; if you wish to speak to the Doctor or obtain advice, please telephone the surgery between **12 noon and 12.30 pm**.

**HOME VISITS**

If you are too unwell to attend the surgery and need medical attention, please telephone the surgery **before 11.00am**. The Doctor may need to speak to you to assess the need for a home visit; visits take place after morning surgery and in the afternoon.

**EMERGENCIES**

Emergency cover out of normal surgery hours is provided by Primicare between 6.00pm and 8.00am Mon. to Fri. and from 6.00pm Fri. until 8.00am Mon. If you need a doctor during these times, please phone **0330 1239309**. If you need to speak to a doctor between 8.00am and 8.30am, please phone the surgery. **REPEAT PRESCRIPTIONS**

You may order repeat prescriptions in writing, in person or by telephone. Please allow 48 hours between ordering and collecting your repeat medication. Requests for emergency medication out of hours should be made to Primicare.
